1. Welcome and Apologies:

5. Precept

Diane Roberts provided extract of 2018/19 budget, and quarterly spend.

Went through the current budget. Figure of £12,205 arrived at. Precept for 2019/20 to be £9,750 same as previous year. Precept not going to be raised for the year 2019/20. Community Council will co-fund.

6. Community Transport Project

Elen explained that transport is an issue in local communities. Need to look at ways of providing rural transport, but to do so would require a feasibility study by creating a questionnaire to find out whether there is such a need in Llangernyw. Garffild to ask Ifor Lloyd – Councillor for Llanfair TH and Betws yn Rhos to do the same.

Match funding required for the project locally. Elen asked the councillors whether they would agree in principle to push the process forward by preparing for the questionnaires.

Councillors agreed in principle, but need to know the cost before full support could be offered.
